Responsibilities:

- Prepare and cook breakfasts, lunches, and snacks for students, adhering to established menus, recipes, and portion sizes.
- Ensure that all meals meet nutritional requirements and food safety regulations.
- Collaborate with the kitchen team to streamline operations and maintain a clean, organized workspace, in compliance with health and safety regulations.
- Follow proper sanitation procedures and guidelines for the handling, preparation, and storage of food.
- Monitor food supplies and ingredients, placing orders as needed to maintain adequate inventory levels.
- Monitor and record temperatures of food and storage areas to ensure safety standards are met.
- Assist in the setup and cleanup of serving areas, including serving students during meal times.
- Adhere to school policies and procedures, as well as state and federal regulations related to school nutrition programs.
- Follow proper food safety and sanitation procedures at all times to ensure the health and safety of students and staff.
- Maintain a positive and cooperative relationship with school administration, faculty, and students.
