SCHOOL DISTRICT LEGAL REFERENCE NOTE

This note is added to the minutes of the July 15, 2024 Organizational Meeting of the Board of Education as a legal reference to the change in status of our school district caused by the Revised School Code (MCL 380.1 et seq) amendments, which became effective July 1, 1996.

- 1. Legal name of school district: Newaygo Public School District
- 2. Prior to July 1, 1996, this district was classified as a fourth class school district. On July 1, 1996, the district became a general powers school district by operation of law.
- 3. The Board of Education is comprised of 7 members, who are elected for terms of six years. (Board approved changes December 21, 2009)
