SNOWCOMING DANCE INFO:

- The SNOWCOMING DANCE is Saturday, January 25th from 7:00 to 10:00 pm at the high school. Tickets are \$10.00. Ticket sales will begin Wednesday, January 15th during both lunches.
- DANCE GUESTS: Guest permission slips are required for any student who does not attend NHS. Guest forms are located in the library or on the website. Return completed forms to the library. All forms are due no later than Wednesday, January 22nd. No late forms will be accepted past 3:00 p.m. on January 22nd. NO middle school students are allowed to attend NHS dances nor guests over 20 years old. If you have any questions, please see Mrs. Piccard.
- DANCE DRESS CODE: Homecoming is a semi-formal dance which means typical school clothing is not suitable. The Dress Code Requirements are:
 - GUYS: Dress pants or Khaki's and dress shirt (NO Jeans and NO t-shirts)
 - GAL'S: Traditional dress/skirt. Semi-formal or formal gowns. Gowns may: be strapless, have spaghetti straps, have bare or open backs. Gowns may NOT: have bare midriff, be see through, show undergarments, have slits above mid-thigh, be extremely low-cut
 - See Mrs. Piccard if you have any questions or concerns about proper attire. You will NOT be allowed in the dance if you violate the dress code.

END OF YEAR INCENTIVE TRIP
